



The Certificate in Christian Leadership is a 24 credit undergraduate-level academic program designed to provide an educational background to laity who are or will be providing leadership positions in Anglican parishes. The Certificate is especially helpful for those who have a role in a parish's Christian Education program. The Certificate program requires no post-secondary requirements in order to enroll.

Required courses include:

- MB 303: Faith Building and the Bible (3 credit hours)
- BC 305: General Introduction to the Bible (3 credit hours)
- BC 405: Inductive Bible Study: Ephesians (3 credit hours)
- CH 302: Survey of the Church History (3 credit hours)
- TH 400: Catholic Theology (3 credit hours)

At least three courses from the following:

- BC 315: Old Testament Survey (3 credit hours)
- BC 335: New Testament Survey (3 credit hours)
- MI 317: Parish Administration (3 credit hours)
- MI 327: Pastoral Counseling (3 credit hours)
- CE 424: Christian Education for Parish Ministry (3 credit hours)
- CE 434: Teaching for Learning and Spiritual Development (3 credit hours)
- TH 350: Liturgical Theology (3 credit hours)
