The Certificate in Bible

The Certificate in Bible is a one year academic program designed to provide students a basic foundation in the study and application of the Holy Scriptures. It is an eighteen credit hour program with no post-secondary requirements necessary to enroll.

Graduates of this program will be able to:

1. Display basic understanding of the structure, content, inspiration, and canonicity of Word of God.
2. Demonstrate biblically-informed leadership skills for service in the church.
3. Evidence a biblical foundation for daily life.
